Volunteer Center Presentation with Ani Etter

- The Volunteer Center has been serving the community for over 40 years and is committed to providing individuals with opportunities for meaningful volunteer experiences.
- They provide <u>resources</u> for volunteer coordinators to better engage with volunteers.
- Ani shared that they are seeing a decline in volunteers who are over the age of 60
- Younger generations are interested in serving. However, they tend to deter long commitments in terms of volunteering.
- The Volunteer Center also has an <u>I CAN Volunteer Team</u> that provides volunteer opportunities for individuals of all ages with developmental and intellectual disabilities.
- After the meeting, Ani shared via email about the success of converting volunteers into donors to the organization. Some of their volunteers make small monetary contributions, while others have become large, steady donors. The key is connecting at a personal level and finding the delicate balance between asking volunteers to give dollars versus asking volunteers to financially support and be

part of something great that they already believe in. Another key component is avoiding a transactional feeling with a volunteer who is already committed to your organization.
